JOB SUMMARY

First Tee – Greater Richmond (FTGR) is a youth development organization that uses the game of golf and its inherent values to shape the lives of young people from all walks of life. We are strengthening the character of the community by providing programs that build resilience in our youth, teach critical life skills, and provide caring adult supervision in a safe environment.

The Elson Redmond Memorial Driving Range is an award-winning, premier practice facility located just north of Downtown Richmond. With an expansive Bermuda grass driving range tee, practice putting and chipping green, six-hole par three course and Trackman 4 simulator room, the facility attracts golfers of all ages and skill levels.

The Outside Staff's main responsibility is picking and cleaning golf balls for the driving range. This includes operating the picking car and apparatus as well as some hand picking. Outside Staff is also responsible for maintaining the upkeep of the picking car, apparatus, and ball washer. Our outside staff is expected to work flexible hours and often on weekends and holidays. Hours are also dependent on the weather, as the facility closes or use of the facility does not require operation.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Utilizes picker and shag bags to collect all range balls possible
- Cleans and separates range balls utilizing ball washing machine
- Helps maintain professional appearance of the facility at all times.
- Maintains club washing bucket
- Maintains upkeep of the picking equipment and ball washing machine

JOB REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS

- Positive and professional demeanor, must be a team player.
- Effective and proactive team communication, facilitation, problem solving, and decision making.
- Must pass a background check
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Ability to lift 50 lbs. to shoulder height
